Revised Weeks at a Glance (WAG) Rollout Schedule

What: Structure and Alignment

- WAG curriculum will continue to be offered for grades 6–12.
- WAG is shifting from daily lesson plans to weekly unit plans. It is being restructured into four 9-week WAG Terms, replacing the 30-day segments (Days 1–30, 31–60, etc.). The WAG Terms can be integrated into any calendar schedule, such as quarterly in a semester system or weekly in a trimester system.
- A WAG Term Instructional Guide will be provided at each grade level to support the implementation and sequencing of units.
- Topics will be offered simultaneously in each grade level WAG Term across middle school and high school wherever possible to support educators who teach multiple levels of the AVID Elective.
- The AVID Elective Standards have been revised to align with the AVID Essential Skills, and the WAG Terms will cover these revised standards, incorporating current AVID curriculum and best instructional practices.
- WAG student resources will now be accessible in Google Docs, Microsoft Word, and fillable PDF formats. Facilitation slide decks, available in Google Slides and Microsoft PowerPoint, are now included for each unit.

When and Where: Transition Year and Rollout

- During the 2023–2024 school year, the existing WAG and select WAG Terms will be posted and available through MyAVID.
- Districts or states that need time to adopt the revised AVID Elective Standards may continue to use the current WAG and Standards.
- The WAG Term units for Terms 1 and 2 will roll out onto the new WAG website monthly during the fall of 2023. The remaining terms will be available during the 2024–2025 school year:
 - WAG Term 1: Available August 1 and September 1, 2023
 - o WAG Term 2: Available October 1 and November 1, 2023
 - WAG Term 3: Available Fall 2024
 - o WAG Term 4: Available Winter 2025

How: Recommendations for the Use of WAG Terms 1 and 2

To support AVID educators during the transition year and facilitate the adoption of the new WAG terms, we offer the following recommendations tailored to their experience level:

AVID Elective Teacher Experience Level	WAG Recommendation
New AVID Elective Teachers (years 1–3)	Use <u>current WAG</u> (Days 1–180).
Experienced AVID Elective Teachers (years 4–6)	Use <u>current WAG</u> (Days 1–180), adding in units from Terms 1 and 2 on the <u>new WAG website</u> as needed to address gaps (e.g., College and Career Readiness Framework Unit, Financial Literacy, Disciplinary Literacy Reading Units).
Advanced AVID Elective Teachers (years 7 and beyond)	Strategically supplement the existing WAG with all available units from Terms 1 and 2 on the new WAG website .
